This year, City of Lakes Waldorf School is celebrating 35 years of Waldorf education in urban Minneapolis. From our inspired beginnings in 1989, we have become a mature and established Waldorf School in the heartland of North America. With the passage of time, the relevance of Waldorf education continues to grow. In our fast-paced and divisive world, CLWS serves as an educational oasis, providing a human- and heart-centered learning experience for our students, and a warm and supportive community for parents and school staff. Students receive a well-rounded education, grow confident, and are a part of a loving social community. The ultimate goal of Waldorf education is to awaken the full capacities of a child so they are free to be fully themselves, and live a life of meaning and purpose.

While trends in public and private education are constantly changing to include an emphasis on everything from project-based learning to social-emotional development or the advanced integration of technology, Waldorf education remains true to the foundational principles that guide the healthy development of the whole child in our changing world. The principles guiding Waldorf methods are based on the fundamental assumption that every human being enters the world with an equally precious destiny to fulfill.

We provide an environment for students to learn to be in meaningful relationship to each other and to the world around them. Social-emotional learning has always been central to the Waldorf educational experience: students form long term relationships, and are a part of a classroom community that is central to their 8-plus-year journey at CLWS. Skills in collaboration and cooperation, along with the development of a sense of responsibility for others and courage for the truth are the natural result of this relationship-based education.

Our students move out into the world confident in their myriad capacities, and mindful of the role they play within the community. With the foundation built through

Waldorf education, they are free to chart their own course, and to develop their full potential throughout their lives.

#### **PARTICIPATION**


